Summary of Findings:

The audit was conducted to assess Manipur Technical University's compliance with the proactive disclosure requirements under Section 4(1)(b) of the RTI Act, 2005. While many parameters have been satisfactorily met, certain areas need improvement and timely disclosure on the University's official website.

Conclusion:

The audit of the Suo Moto Disclosure under Section 4(1)(b) of the RTI Act, 2005 for Manipur Technical University reveals a fair level of compliance with the statutory obligations. However, immediate corrective actions are necessary in the partially and non-complied areas to ensure full compliance, legal conformity, and improved public transparency.

Recommendations:

- Ensure timely updates of all proactive disclosures on the university's official website.
- Publish comprehensive details for all officers, employees, and internal committees.
- Disclose relevant financial details, including expenditure, for better public understanding.
- Share any additional information that promotes transparency and enhances public trust.
