PROCEEDINGS OF THE 9th MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL, MANIPUR TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY, IMPHAL HELD ON 30th MAY, 2026.

The 9th Meeting of Academic Council of Manipur Technical University, Imphal was held on 30th May, 2026 at the Conference Hall of Manipur Technical University with Prof. W. Chandbabu Singh, Vice-Chancellor of the University in the chair.

The list of participants is enclosed as Annexure.

At the outset, the Chairman of the Academic Council of Manipur Technical University welcomed all the members of the Council. The agenda set for the meeting were discussed one after another. The resolutions taken on them are as detailed below:

A. Action Taken Report of the 8th meeting of the Academic Council held on 6th November, 2025.

1. Ph.D. and PG Ordinances of Manipur Technical University:

- i) The Academic Council noted the amendment/insertion of Ph.D and PG ordinances of MTU. The Academic Council also noted the commencement of Ph.D. programme at MTU.
- ii) The Academic Council also noted the approval of Board of Management for opening of M.Tech. M.Sc., M.A., Certificate, Short-term and Diploma programmes at MTU.
- iii) The Academic Council opined that the University may change the nomenclature of M.Tech. in Biotechnological Engineering to M.Sc. Biotechnology.
- iv) The Academic Council also noted the amendment of Section 19.2 in both the PG ordinances.

2. Award of Degrees:

The Academic Council also noted Award of degrees for passed out students of 2025-26.

3. Minor Modification in the design of Certificates:

The Academic Council also noted the minor modifications in the design of Certificates.

4. **1st Convocation of Manipur Technical University:**

The Academic Council also noted the organising of 1st Convocation of MTU on 29th January, 2026 at City Convention Centre, Imphal.

5. **Academic and Administrative Audit Report, Green/Environment Audit Report and Institutional Development Plan**

The Academic Council also noted that approved documents of *Academic and Administrative Audit Report, Green/Environment Audit Report* and *Institutional Development Plan*. It was noted that the documents will be submitted once the NAAC portal is opened.

6. **Opening of B.Tech. in Biomedical Engineering:**

The Academic Council also noted the programme will be opened based on availability of infrastructure, faculty position etc. at a later phase.

7. **Publishing of Bi-annual Newsletter of MTU:**

The Academic Council also noted the publication of 1st volume of Bi-annual Newsletter of MTU "Nexus". It was noted that the next publication will be published in the month of July and the same shall be released on the Foundation Day of the University on 5th August every year.

8. **MTU Journal of Science, Engineering, Management & Humanities:**

The Academic Council also noted that the University is in the process to constitute a committee for publishing the above journal.

9. **Generation of University Fund (Revenue) from MTU's Permanent Campus at Khaidem:**

The Chairman apprised the members of Academic Council that a request for demarcation was sent to Deputy Commissioner, Imphal West. The Academic Council noted that action from the district administration is still awaited. Once the demarcation is completed then University may use a portion of land for gardening and other agricultural activities and generate funds for the university.

10. **Inter-se Seniority List of Assistant Professors of MTU as per Clause 16.3 of UGC Regulations 2018**

The Academic Council also noted that, with approval of BOM, the University has issued notifications and uploaded them on the University website. However, some members opined that the University should include the date of joining and the grade of the Assistant Professors in the seniority list. After due deliberation, the Council resolves to include the date of joining and the grade of the Assistant Professors in the seniority list.

11. R&D Policy and Guidelines

The Academic Council noted the approval of the BoM of the R&D Policy and Guidelines of the University and the same has been uploaded in the University Website.

12. MoU Signing

The Academic Council noted the signing of the MoU between Manipur Technical University and the Suan Dusit University, Bangkok on 29th November, 2025. It was also noted that dignitaries from Suan Dusit University also visited Manipur Technical University and held interaction programme with the faculties and research scholars on 6th May, 2026.

B. AGENDA:

Agenda No. 1: Opening of new programmes in Manipur Technical University

The Chairman apprised the members of Academic Council that the Board of Management in its 18th meeting held on 12th May, 2026 accorded approval for introduction/opening of new programmes in the University from the academic session 2026–27.

After due deliberation, the Academic Council resolved and approved the opening of the following programmes in the *first phase* at MTU:

- i) M.Tech (Electrical Engineering)
- ii) M.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering)
- iii) M.Tech (Electronics & Communication Engineering)
- iv) M.Tech (Civil Engineering)
- v) M.A. (English Language Teaching)
- vi) M.Sc. (Mathematics)
- vii) 5(Five) year Integrated Master Programme in Tourism and Travel Management
- viii) Short term courses on Computer Concepts/AI.

Further, the Academic Council opined that the University should segregate the short-term programmes such as *Short-Term Courses on Computer Concepts/AI* under its relevant academic department viz. *Department of Computer Science & Engineering*.

Furthermore, the Council deliberated on the significance of the nomenclature of the programme viz. *5(Five) year Integrated Master Programme in Tourism and Travel Management*. Some members proposed alternative nomenclature such as *5(Five) year Integrated Master Programme in Tourism and Hospitality Management*. After due deliberation, the Council resolves that the nomenclature should be decided as per the wisdom of the University in due consideration of the approved programmes of regulatory bodies such as UGC.

Furthermore, the Council also deliberated on prospects of opening of new programmes such as *Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Design and Architectural Engineering* at Manipur Technical University and resolved that the University will take up a feasibility study in this aspect. The report will be placed in the Council again at an appropriate time.

Furthermore, the Council accorded approval to the Course curricula and Entrance test syllabi recommended by the respective Board of Studies of the following programmes:

- i) M.Tech (Electrical Engineering)
- ii) M.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering)
- iii) M.Tech (Electronics & Communication Engineering)
- iv) M.Tech (Civil Engineering)
- v) M.A. (English Language Teaching)
- vi) M.Sc. (Mathematics)
- vii) 5(Five) year Integrated Master Programme in Tourism and Travel/Hospitality Management
- viii) Short term courses on Computer Concepts/AI.

Agenda No. 2: Spot Admission for B.Tech., Lateral Entry, MBA candidates.

The Academic Council accorded approval for Spot Admission mode of intake of eligible candidates for admission to the B.Tech., Lateral Entry, MBA programmes if seats are left vacant after normal mode of intake.

Agenda No. 3: MTU Heirok Campus.

The Academic Council noted that as per directives of the Government of Manipur, Manipur Technical University has been exploring the modalities for using the Heirok Engineering College's infrastructure as it has been lying idle for many years after its completion of construction. The council also noted that after due deliberation of the matter in the last BOM meeting held on 12th May, 2026, the BOM recommended for using the Heirok Engineering College's infrastructure after due deliberation with the Govt. of Manipur.

Agenda No. 4: Ex-post facto approval for opening of Facilitation Cell of MTU:

The Academic Council accorded ex-post facto approval for the constitution of a Facilitation Cell of the University for extending assistance to candidates for submission of online application forms for admission into B.Tech programmes for the academic session 2026-27.

Agenda No. 5: Promotion of teachers under Career Advancement Scheme-2018

The Academic Council accorded approval for adoption of UGC Regulation, 2018 for promotion of teachers of the University under Career Advancement Scheme.

Agenda No. 6: Adjunct Faculty of MTU:

The Academic Council approved in-principle introduction of Adjunct Faculty scheme of the UGC in the MTU. Vice-Chancellor has been entrusted for reporting list of the recommended Adjunct faculty members in the next meeting of the Academic Council.

Agenda No. 7: Adoption of UGC guidelines for engagement of Professor of Practice:

The Academic Council approved in-principle for adoption of UGC guidelines for engagement of Professor of Practice at MTU.

Agenda No. 8: Introduction of Emeritus Fellowship Programme at MTU:

The Academic Council approved in-principle for introduction of an Emeritus Fellowship programme at MTU. The modalities of the said programme will be placed before the next meeting.

Agenda No. 9: Miscellaneous Agenda:

i) Implementation of SAMARTH ERP at MTU

The Chairman apprised the members of Academic Council that the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India has accorded approval on 27th March, 2026 for implementation of SAMARTH ERP system at Manipur Technical University and accordingly, the BOM in its 18th meeting held on 12th May, 2026 accorded approval for implementation of SAMARTH ERP system at Manipur Technical University.

The Academic Council concurred with the resolution of 18th BOM meeting.

ii) Revision of existing Course Curricula/Syllabi of B.Tech and MBA programmes:

The Chairman highlighted the necessity of revision of existing Course Curricula/Syllabi of B.Tech and MBA programmes at MTU. The Academic Council accorded approval for revision of existing Course Curricula/Syllabi of B.Tech and MBA programmes. The revised Course Curricula/Syllabi are to be placed before the next Academic Council for approval. The revised curricula should incorporate the aspects of the **Indian Knowledge perspectives** at appropriate areas of the syllabi.

iii) Village Adoption Policy of MTU:

The Academic Council approved in-principle for **Village Adoption Policy of MTU**. The proposed Village Adoption Policy of MTU is to be placed before the next meeting for approval.

iv) **Workshop Programme on Question Paper Setting:**

The Academic Council accorded approval for organising a workshop for the faculties on setting of Question Papers on priority basis. The workshop should also discuss the **Common Question Paper Model of the University**.

v) **Amendment of Clause No. 4.1 of MTU Ordinance No.14:**

The Academic Council accorded approval for amendment of Clause No. 4.1 of MTU No. 14 as

(a) Civil Engineering: Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or a relevant degree in an appropriate area from a recognized Institution, and preferably a valid GATE/NET score.

(b) Computer Science & Engineering: Bachelor's degree in Computer Science & Engineering/Information Technology or a relevant degree in an appropriate area or MSc (Computer Science/Information Technology) or MCA from a recognized Institution, and preferably a valid GATE/NET score.

(c) Electrical Engineering: Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology in Electrical or Electronics & Communication or Electrical & Electronics or Mechanical or Automobile or Robotics or Mechatronics or a relevant degree in an appropriate area or MSc (Physics) from a recognized Institution, and preferably a valid GATE/NET score.

(d) Electronics & Communication Engineering: Bachelor's degree in Electronics & Communication Engineering or Electrical Engineering or a relevant degree in an appropriate area or MSc (Electronics) from a recognized Institution, and preferably a valid GATE/NET score.

(e) Mechanical Engineering: Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering or in an appropriate area from a recognized Institution, and preferably a valid GATE/NET score.

vi) **Revision of curriculum and credit framework for Ph.D coursework in Mathematics**

The Council examined the proposal recommended by the Board of Studies of Mathematics and accorded approval to the following:

(a) Course code change in respect of "Research Methodology" and "Research and Publication Ethics"

(b) Introduction of “Number Theory” as an elective course

The meeting ends with thanks from the Chairman.
